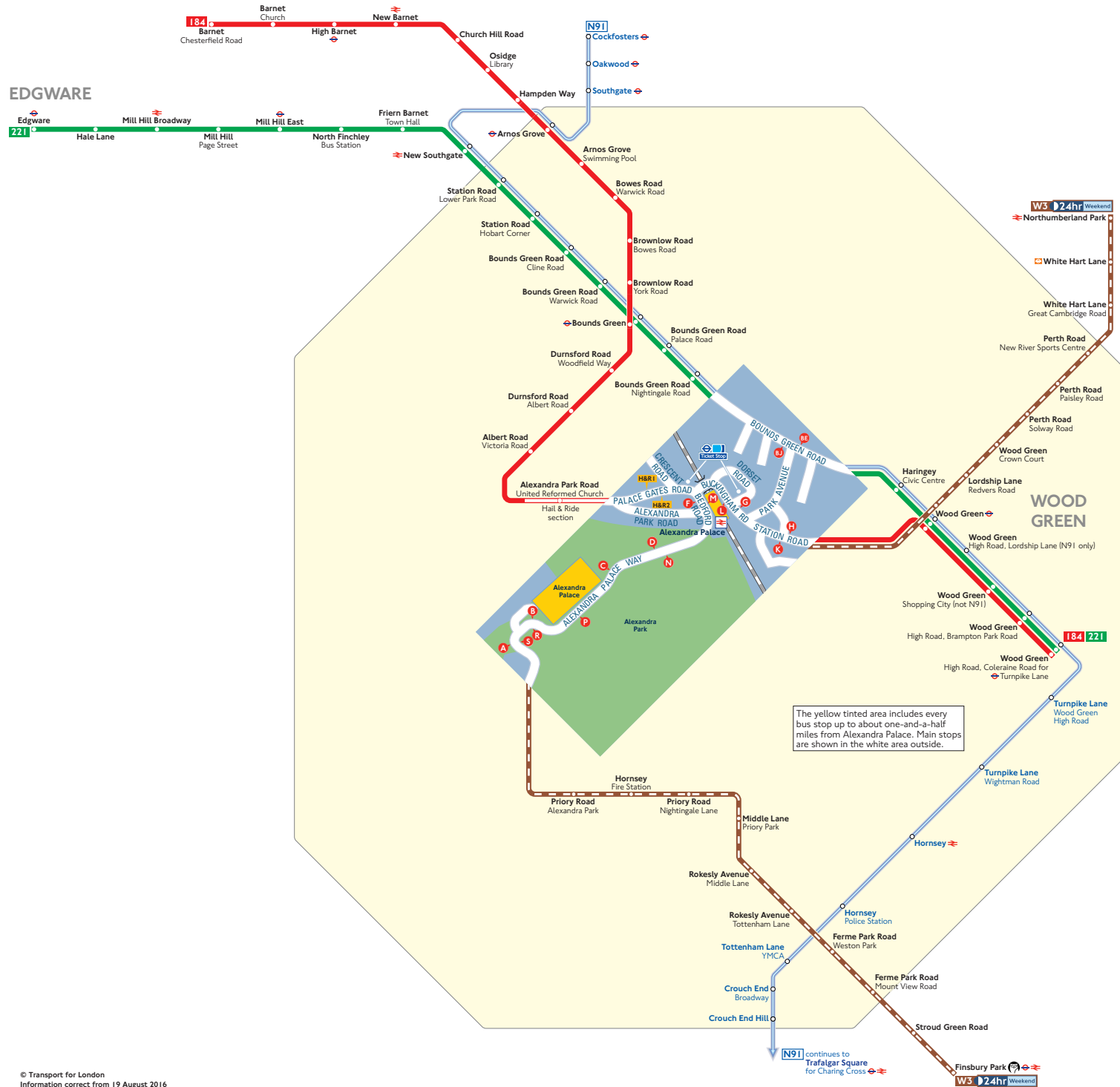

### Special note:

Buses between Alexandra Palace and Alexandra Palace Station and Wood Green serve stops **B** and **C** outside Alexandra Palace. Buses between Alexandra Palace Station and Alexandra Palace serve stops **L** and **M** outside the station.

Route 184 operates as Hail & Ride on the sections of roads marked **H&R1** and **H&R2** on the map. Buses stop at any safe point along the road. There are no bus stops at these locations, but please indicate clearly to the driver when you wish to board or alight.
